Saddarshanam

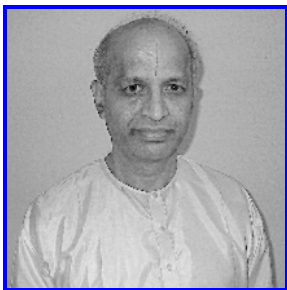
(Vision of the Truth)
